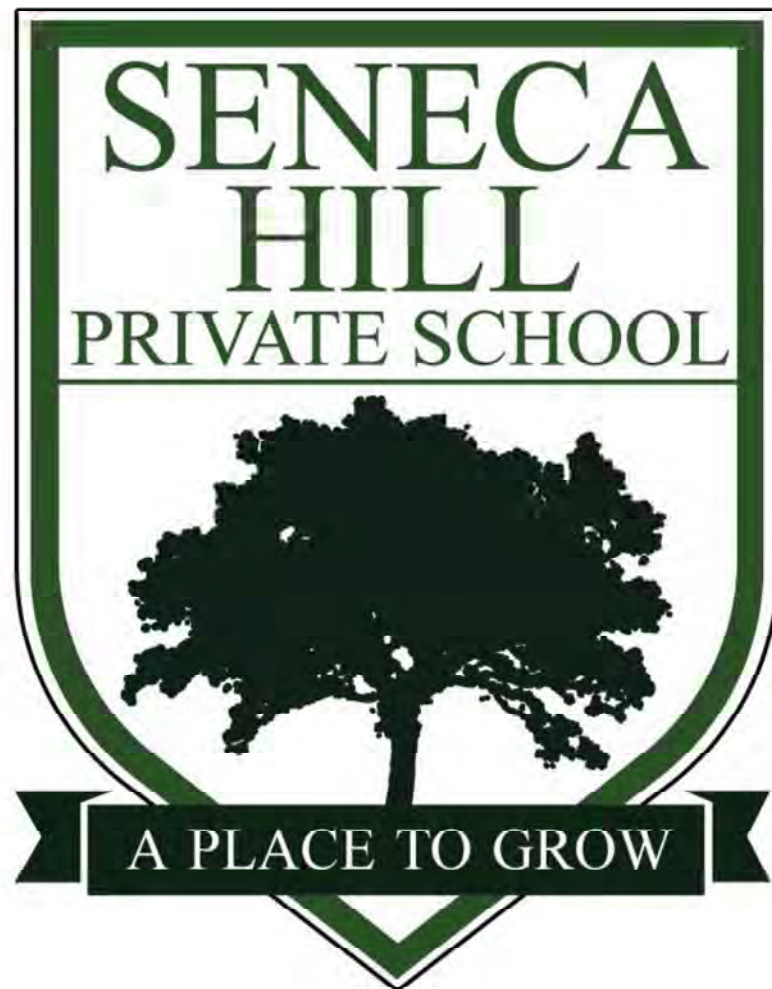

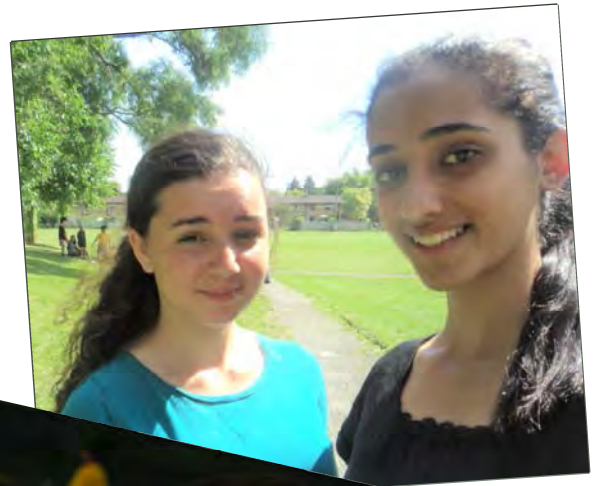

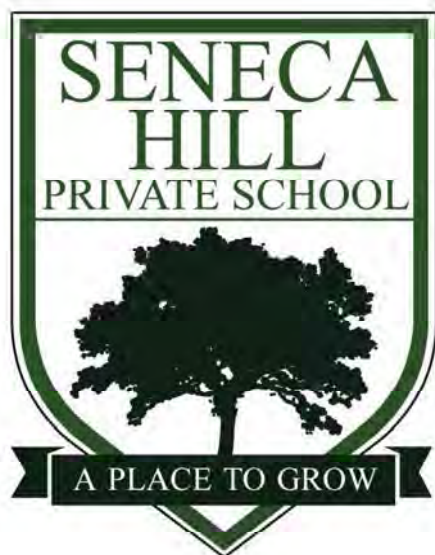

Application Process

Thank you for your interest in Seneca Hill!

Each year, Seneca Hill offers a limited number of spots for international students to join our full-time program. We offer a strong integration program, a rigorous English as a Second Language (ESL) program and welcome centre to help international students make a smooth transition to their new life in Canada. We are here to help them through every step of the way. We invite you to speak with our Admissions Office, Principal, current students and teachers in order to understand how we can provide an enriched educational experience for your child.

Application Process

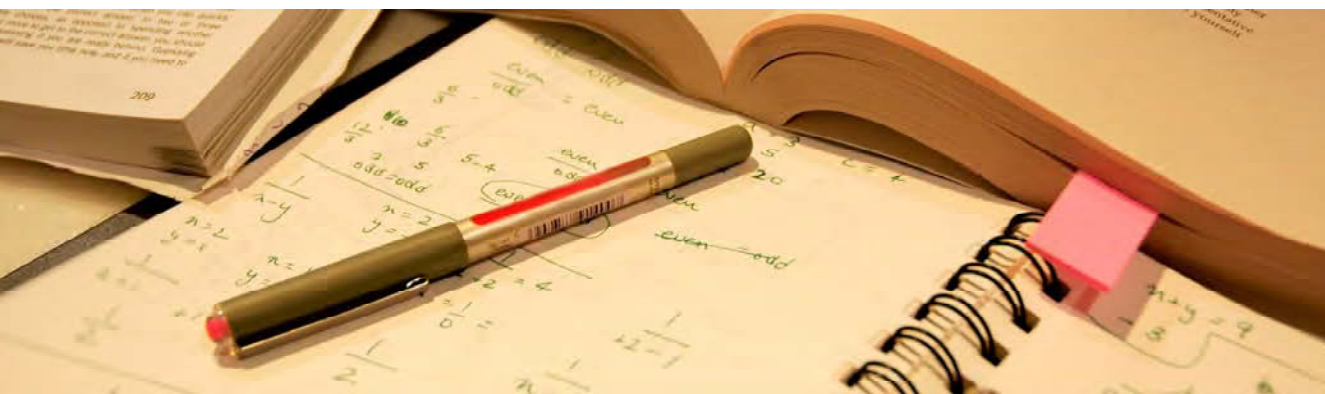
Please submit the following to the school office or by email to admissions@senecahill.ca

- Application Form – Student Bio, Dietary Restrictions / Allergy Information, etc.
- Copy of the two most recent end-of-year report cards
- Letter of Recommendation from Principal or former Teacher
- Copy of Immunization Record
- Proof of Health Insurance Coverage (or will be automatically enrolled in school health insurance plan)
- Copy of the applicant's passport
- Non-refundable application fee

Once these documents have been submitted, our admissions team will review the entire application. A response is usually given within 5 business days of receipt of application materials. If the applicant is accepted into the program, a conditional offer letter will be issued with payment details. We will require the following in order to issue an admissions letter for visa purposes:

1. Full payment of the school's tuition fees.
2. Details of living arrangements and custodianship in Toronto with parent/guardian declaration, or application for Seneca Hill's homestay program.

After receiving this information, Seneca Hill will issue an official letter of acceptance and tuition receipt, which can be used for study visa application and immigration purposes.
